Application for a family reunification visa has to be submitted **personally** at the Visa Section, Embassy of Switzerland, Chandragupta Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi - 110 021. In order to schedule an appointment with the Embassy, please visit the following link and book an appointment online:

The authorization lies in the competence of the migration office of the respective canton in Switzerland, therefore please submit **3 application forms + original and 2 sets of photocopies** of the required documents as specified below:

Please note:

- The required documents have to be submitted with the visa application (no fax or e-mail to Embassy accepted).
- Only the documents mentioned on the checklist are accepted.
- The Embassy of Switzerland reserves the right to ask for additional documents and/or for a personal interview.

Procedure:

The entire application will be forwarded to the competent cantonal migration office for its decision (6-12 weeks).

Information regarding the processing time will be given by the authorities in Switzerland only.

Once the authorization to enter Switzerland has been granted (Form: 'Ermächtigung zur Visumerteilung' or 'Autorisation habilitant les représentations Suisses à délivrer un visa'), the passport and the authorization may be submitted directly to VFS Global Services by the applicant or by a third person without prior appointment.

The entry visa will allow you to travel through the Schengen states and enter Switzerland during its validity.

Within the first 14 days of your initial entry you have to declare your arrival at the Residents Registration Office at your place of residence (German: 'Einwohnerkontrolle', French: 'Contrôle des habitants'; Italian: 'Controllo degli abitanti').

The residence permit will be issued upon notification of your arrival in Switzerland.

Voluntary verification:

Your official documents might need to be verified and legalized by this embassy, this process takes 3 - 4 months and an advance payment of CHF 1'000.00 is required.

The decision to request a verification will be taken by the Swiss authorities after receiving your application file.

To speed up the processing of your file, you may request a voluntary verification by the Embassy before the file is transmitted to Switzerland.

Information for Certificate of Identity (CoI) and Identity Certificate (IC) holders:

Additionally required documents are:

- valid Residence Certificate (RC)
- valid Return Visa

The Return Visa may be submitted once the authorization is received.
